THEOLOGY, PHILOSOPHY AND RELIGION

13+ CE ESSENTIAL INFORMATION

There is no change to the published date for the TPR and TPR (Roman Catholicism) examinations.

Prep schools are reminded that each Section of both TPR specifications is divided into two **themes**. As there will always be two questions per theme, then where time has been limited then it is acceptable and expedient to focus and prepare pupils for just one theme in a Section.

This will reduce the number of questions a candidate might be able to choose from, but this has to be weighed against having to learn less material but more thoroughly.

A reminder: only **two** questions must be answered from any two of the three Sections.

13+ CE ADDITIONAL GUIDANCE

For those studying the **TPR specification**, the **themes** are:

Section 1 Theology: God's Relationship to the World; Human Responses to God

Section 2 Philosophy: Great Thinkers and Their Ideas; Ethics

Section 3 Religion: Beliefs and Teachings; Practices and Ceremonies (for the chosen religion)

For those studying the **TPR Roman Catholicism** specification, the **themes** are:

Section 1: The Old Covenant: God and the World; Living the Covenant

Section 2: Jesus Christ and the Kingdom of God: The Example of Christ; The Kingdom of God

Section 3: The Church and Sacraments: Church and Life; The Sacramental Life



Given the intentions of the scholarship examinations and the skills-focused nature of the questions, we recommend that scholars cover the full range of topics and skills specified within the published syllabus for TPR.
