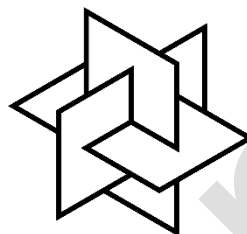

### SECTION 1

Use the vocabulary provided to help you translate the following sentences into German.

You are given the gender of nouns (in brackets) and the infinitive of one verb in each sentence. Any separable verb is shown with a slash (e.g. auf/stehen). You need to add extra words as necessary and make sure that the word order is correct in German.

1. I like cooking in my free time.

*kochen; Freizeit (f)*

2. At the weekend, we're going into the town centre by bus.

*Wochenende (n); fahren; Stadtmitte (f); Bus (m)*

3. Do you play tennis with my brother every day?

## SECTION 2

Write an email in German to a German friend. You should write between 80 and 120 words. (You may use only the present tense if you wish, but you will need to show knowledge of **past**, **present** and **future** tenses in order to access the top marks, and you will be credited for the accurate use of a wide variety of vocabulary and grammar.)

You must include at least **four** of the following:

- Lieblingsfach – *your favourite subject*
- Kleider – *clothes*
- Musik in der Schule – *music at school*
- Oma – *grandma*
- Schlafzimmer – *bedroom*
