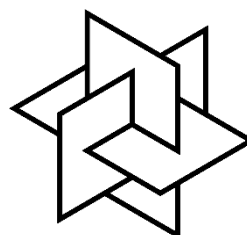

Instructions

You are allowed 10 minutes to prepare both the Role-play task and the Text-based task.

During the preparation time, you may use a dictionary and make notes which may be referred to during the Role-play and Text-based tasks **only**.

These notes must be written on the lined paper provided. You must **not** write on this card.

Give your notes and this card to your teacher at the end of the test.

Information

This examination consists of **three** parts.

The **first** part is a role-play situation. Carry out the tasks indicated and be ready to answer a question during the conversation.

The **second** part consists of a conversation with your teacher, lasting about 3 minutes, based on the stimulus text provided. Use this information to answer the five questions your teacher will ask.

The **third** part takes the form of an open conversation with your teacher, lasting about 3 minutes, on one or more of the topics listed in the specification. Your teacher will choose the topic(s) and will ask you some questions.

The whole of the examination is to be recorded.

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PART 1

ROLE PLAY

You want to buy some tickets for a music festival, so you go to the Tourist Information Office.

Your teacher will play the role of the tourist guide and will speak first.

Say:

1. I would like some tickets for the music festival, please.
2. Three tickets, please. Two adult and one child.
3. **Answer the question.**
4. I am twelve years old.
5. Thank you. At what time does the festival finish?
6. No, we can walk from our hotel, thank you.

PART 2

TEXT-BASED TASK

You are talking about holidays with a Spanish-speaking friend, who will ask you **five** questions about what you normally do in the summer.

Using the information below to help you, answer the questions you are asked. You may respond with just the basic information provided, but you will need to include some opinions and/or additional information of your own in order to access the top marks.

HOLIDAYS

Normally: **Nice, south of France**

Why: **sunny and hot; delicious food**

How long: **2 weeks, July**

Travel: **aeroplane, faster**

Stay: **grandparents' house, near the beach**

Like: **swimming in the sea; eating in French restaurants**

Do not like: **visiting museums, boring**
