

THE ISEB READING CERTIFICATE

The ISEB Reading Certificate works alongside the core English curriculum and is designed to encourage and sustain habitual reading in Years 6, 7 and 8 across a wide variety of genres and formats.

While ISEB does not provide a specific reading list for any of our English exams. The Reading Certificate makes a formal acknowledgement of an individual or cohorts commitment to reading across a range of cultures, periods and literary forms, and is designed to expand pupils' experience and awareness of different genres and perspectives.

WHAT IS IT, AND HOW DOES IT WORK?

To be awarded the certification, pupils are encouraged to read a text under each category provided in the Common Entrance (CE) Engishs specification (page 12). In negotiation with their teacher, pupils complete a task or activity, either individually or as group, to show that they have read the text, demonstrating an understanding of the themes, format and contert.
